

Guide to Better Fuel Economy



1. Check the vehicles air filter regularly for contamination, replace as necessary.
2. Always check the air pressure in the tires, and fill to max (never over-fill).
3. Use the proper fuel recommended by the manufacturer.
4. Using 5w 30 motor oil will help with fuel mileage.
5. Replace spark plugs as recommended in the owners manual (reference-

6. Drive conservatively, never speeding up for red lights.
7. Use a good fuel injector cleaner every other tank of gas.
